Homework and spelling

Reading at Home

Children need to read at least 4 times per week. This needs to be recorded in their planner each time they read and signed by an adult. Children acquire raffle tickets for times they read each week (1 raffle ticket for 4 times, 2 raffle tickets for 5 or more), which is then drawn twice per half term, with the chance of winning a brand-new book of their choice! Children are welcome to bring in their own books from home to read during Reading for Pleasure time in class.

PE

Children have **indoor PE on a Tuesday** and **outdoor PE on a Thursday**. They can come to school on these days in their usual PE kit: plain white t-shirt, dark shorts/bottoms, dark hoodie and suitable trainers.
