Year 4 Newsletter – Thursday 28th March 2024

We've made it to another half term! This week we have enjoyed some Easter filled fun and practised our sewing skills. The children found this really tricky and we were very impressed with their perseverance and determination to master this skill.

Science: In Science, we have learnt that evaporation is the change from liquid to gas. In everyday language, the process can be called drying or drying up. The children worked scientifically to consider how to speed up the rate of evaporation... and how to make the material's particles more excited!

<u>Maths</u>: This week, we continued our learning on decimals. We have been dividing whole numbers by 10 and 100 and consolidating this in a range of different reasoning and problem solving activities.

English: This week we have published our Roman narrative: these were fantastic! Filled with pace, tension and some accurate use of speech! In reading, the children continued to work on their inference of character's feelings and explanations for the author's choice of language using evidence from the text.

<u>PE</u>: Our PE days remain on a Tuesday (indoor) and Thursday (outdoor). Children can come to school on these days in their usual PE kit: plain white t-shirt, dark shorts/bottoms, dark hoodie and suitable trainers.
