Kooth online services can offer mental health support to children aged 10 and over.

• Their team of mental health professionals can provide mental health support within 15 minutes of contact. They offer:

- Free, anonymous support: their chat service is free, and you don't even have to give your name.
- Real people, not bots: the professionals you speak with in their chat service are real people who want to listen to you.
- A safe space to talk: the Kooth chat service is a safe space for support accredited by the British Association for Counselling and Psychology (BACP).
