## Homework and spelling

Homework will be handed out on a Thursday. Spelling homework is handed out on Mondays. Children have a week to practise before they are tested the following Monday. Reading, Grammar and Maths homework is handed out on a Thursday, to be completed and handed in the following Thursday. <u>Please ensure this is completed on time. If we can help in any way, please let us know.</u>

## Reading at Home

Children need to read <u>at least 4 times per week</u>. This needs to be recorded in their planner each time they read and <u>signed by an adult</u>. Children acquire raffle tickets for the amount of times they read each week (1 raffle ticket for 4 times, 2 raffle tickets for 5 or more), which is then drawn twice per half term, with the chance of winning a brand-new book of their choice! Children are welcome to bring in their own books from home to read during Reading for Pleasure time in class.

## <u>PE</u>

Children have **indoor PE on a Tuesday** and **outdoor PE on a Thursday**. They can come to school on these days in their usual PE kit: plain white t-shirt, dark shorts/bottoms, dark hoodie and suitable trainers.
