#### Homework

This week, we have sent home copies of the homework instead of posting it on the google classroom. One side is maths and related to statistics and reading tables and timetables. On the other side, is a short reading comprehension with questions to answer based on the text. We expect this back in school to mark as a class on 11th November 2021.

#### <u>Spellings</u>

This week the pupils have learnt the 'kn' sound. Each child has taken home a homework sheet to complete to help consolidate the sound. They have a paragraph of text to read and should highlight any of the kn- sounds that they see. They then have some questions to answer around the text. The children should return this to school by **8**<sup>th</sup> **November 2021.** 

This week's spelling rule: kn- e.g. knife, knowledge, knee, know, knot.

<u>This week's statutory spellings to learn:</u> correspond, criticise, curiosity, definite and desperate.

## Reading at Home:

This year, all children will record their reading on our new virtual reading log: Go Read. This can be accessed via any device, which allows access to the internet, including mobile phones.
