## <u>Maths:</u>

In maths, the children have continued to practise learning subtraction strategies. We have worked on subtracting with exchanging using visuals to help the children understand what happens when exchanging. A link has been posted on the Google Classroom to help your child's understanding.

**Homework**: Children have all received a piece of handwriting and maths or reading homework. Please encourage your child to focus on sitting their letters on the line, use equal finger spaces and have consistent letter sizes.

**English**: In English, the children have continued to write their newspaper report based on the book 'Pugs of the Frozen North' by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre. The children have continued to use the taught features of a newspaper report and they have loved reading the book.
