Year 3 Newsletter – Friday 19th November 2021

This week, pupils have enjoyed taking part in anti-bullying week. They have enjoyed creating their own anti-bullying superhero and have thought hard about the name of their superhero, their outfit and powers. They have enjoyed a range of activities across the week to support their understanding of what bullying is and what to do if they are being bullied.

Home reading: Thank you to all parents and carers who are logging their child's home reading via Go Read. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you need support with this. Reading books will continue to be changed every Monday. Each child has been given a large plastic wallet to make the passing of letters and carrying and exchanging of books easier.

Google Classroom: Please continue to use the Google Classroom page as usual for any key information and to view any learning shared. Your child has their own log in details.

<u>Homework and Spellings</u>: On Monday, the children will be tested on words with the 'u' sound made by the letters 'ou'. They will be tested on a selection of these spellings that they have learnt across the week. There will be 10 in total. Their home learning and spelling task has been sent out with the children.

<u>Maths:</u> In maths, the children have begun the unit of multiplication and have learnt about the vocabulary of multiplication, the understanding of arrays and how multiplication is the same as repeated addition. We have worked on creating repeated addition sums to match visuals whilst also exploring how this is also written as a multiplication sum using the x sign.

<u>Homework</u>: Children have all received home learning based on multiplication and arrays and they have also received a reading comprehension.

English: In English, the children have continued to write their newspaper report based on the book 'Pugs of the Frozen North' by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre. The children have explored the use of direct speech and how this can be used in a newspaper. They have started the publishing of their writing, ready for display.
