Homework and Spellings:

Next week in phonics the children will be learning different codes for the /l/ sounds at the end of words. The children will learn that the /l/ sounds can be made with /il/ /le/ or /el. Children will read words and sentences with this rule in and will then move onto apply this rule into spelling.

Maths:

In maths next week we will be continuing to learn about time. We will be learning about 5 minute intervals across the next week. We will begin by looking at this practically using our 5 times tables to support us. The children will then learn to read clocks to 5 minute intervals and draw hands on clocks to show the time.

English:

In English next week we will be writing our biographies. The children will be using their plans to write each paragraph trying their best to include conjunctions and descriptive language. Once they have completed their writing they will be reading their writing aloud to their friends to give them information about David Attenborough.
