It has been great to see the children back in school refreshed after the Easter break. Pupils have enjoyed another action-packed week in a variety of subjects. They have enjoyed learning about fractions in maths and how to write a complain letter in English.

Home reading: Please can parents send their child's zip-locked wallet in on a Monday so we can change their books. If you are struggling to log reading via the go-read app please record reading in their red reading records.

Spellings: Pupils have received new spelling homework. This week we have explored the initial 's' sound spelt with ce, ci, cy. It has also been uploaded to the Google Classroom.

Homework: This week, homework concentrates on measuring a perimeter and reading comprehension.

Here is a reminder of what homework you can expect your child to receive each week:

Mondays: Here your child will receive some spelling homework, which links to the rule we have been learning that week. Some children may receive additional phonics homework, which they have covered in smaller phonics interventions.

Thursdays: This is when regular curriculum homework will be sent. This will link in with what has been taught in class that week and usually be reading, writing, maths or science. This week pupils have received home learning based on short multiplication and spelling, grammar and punctuation.
