Homework and Spellings:

Next week in phonics, the children will be recapping some of the rules that we have learnt this half term. We will be focussing on homophones, adding different suffixes and the /tion/ spelling. Children will read words and sentences with these rules in and will then move on to apply these rules into writing sentences.

Maths:

In maths next week we will be learning how to add and subtract numbers where it crosses the ten. The children will be learning to exchange ten ones for a whole ten when adding and exchanging a whole ten for ten ones when they are subtracting.

English:

In English next week we will be writing our narrative based on the book 'Tuesday'. The children will begin by writing the start of the narrative, before moving on to the middle and the end. The children will be using a range of sentence starters and will use a thesaurus to explore different adjectives. Finally the children will read their stories aloud to the class using expression.

PE:
