This week, the children have enjoyed reading lessons based on the story, Omar. We have expanded our vocabulary knowledge with new words such as: 'furrowed', 'bleary' and 'wailing'. In maths, children have continued exploring fractions and they have learnt how to write them on the number line. In science, children have dissected a lily flower and have learned about different parts and functions of a flower.

Oxford Reading Buddy: Hopefully your child has discussed Oxford Reading Buddy with you. They have all been given a password for access at home. The books should be in line with your child's reading attainment. Books with a red symbol are coaching books and guide your child through the text before a quiz. Quizzes are based on skills that we focus on in class-VIPERS (Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval, and Summary).

Spellings: Pupils have received new spelling homework. This week, we have explored the suffix -ly. It has also been uploaded to the Google Classroom.

Homework: This week, homework concentrates on arithmetic and reading comprehension. There will be a weekly homework focus on arithmetic for the remainder of the half term to boost pupil fluency in these strategies. Please ask your child's class teacher if you would like to be shown how we calculate for these.
