SATs:

We are incredibly proud of how hard all of the year 2 children have worked this week! They have handled each paper with maturity and have shown how much they have learnt during their time in KS1. We will be reporting SAT scores to parents in June once the scaled scores have been released.

English:

In English we will be finishing writing our Tuesday stories. The children have loved writing the different parts of their narratives and we are very impressed with how imaginative they are! The children will then spend some time editing their writing before reading them aloud to the class and Miss Hobson.

Maths:

Next week in maths, we will be continuing to develop an understanding of addition and subtraction where the tens are crossed. The children will begin practically by using the dienes before moving to pictorially drawing the tens and ones. We will use the term 'exchange' to explain how a ten will be swapped for ten ones.
