**SATs results and reports:** The children should have received their reports and SATs results yesterday. All of these have been given to the children. They all did so well and they should be so proud of their results. On the letter, there are marks that they got in their tests as well as scaled scores. The one to focus on is their scaled scores. Here is a breakdown of their scaled scores:

- 120 The highest score
- **101-119** A score above 100 (including 120) means a child has exceeded the expected standard
- 100 The expected standard for children (and essentially a 'pass').
- **80 99** A score of 99 or below has not met the expected standard
