This week:

This week the children have been exploring the pumpkins in the tuff tray and discussing how it feels and why pumpkins have seeds in.

In English, the children have started a new unit of writing on the Great Fire of London where they are going to be writing a diary extract on a survivor of the fire. The children have looked at the features of a diary and why people write diaries.

In Maths, the children have continued to look at addition and subtraction where they have found the related facts using simple additions and subtractions for example: $2+3=5$, $20+30=50$.
