Home Learning:

Every Thursday, your child will be set a piece of homework on Google Classrooms comprising of Maths and English (reading and SPAG) which is to be returned the following Thursday.

Spellings:

Your child will receive a piece of spelling homework every Monday (to be returned the following Monday) which will indicate the spelling pattern that they will be tested on the following Monday. Next week, we will be looking at: -si, -s and -z words

Reading:

Please remember that it is expected that:

- Children will read (any book) at home at least 4 times a week
- This reading is to be recorded in their planners either themselves with an adult signature or by an adult who has listened to them read
- Their planner must be brought into school each day and taken home each day
- Children can log their reading on GoBoom if they wish- log ins are available

PE

Indoor PE: Thursday for 5GN

Swimming: Thursday for 5KJ - On the days your child is swimming, they must come to school in their school uniform, with a bag containing their swimming kit and a towel.

Outdoor P.E for both classes: Tuesday. Now the weather is getting colder, please make sure your child comes with tracksuit bottoms/jumper/coat.
