### D:side Visit

In PSHE this half term, each year group will be taking part in a range of workshops across school to explore the theme of 'taking care of our body'. The workshops will be hosted by D:side and will take place on Monday 11<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> of March.

Some of the objectives that will be covered may be quite sensitive to some children. Therefore, we want to inform you of what will be taught in class to give you the opportunity to support your child further at home.

PSHE content that will be taught in the workshop:	
Reception	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Exploring different feelings &amp; emotions</li><li>• Discussing how we take care of our body</li><li>• What are medicines?</li></ul>
Year 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Finding out how our body works</li><li>• Discussing what makes a healthy lunchbox</li><li>• How are we safe around medicines?</li><li>• Exploring exercise and rest</li></ul>
Year 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How we are different to our friends?</li><li>• Discovering different parts of our body and their functions</li><li>• Discussing how we are all special</li></ul>
Year 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Exploring smoking &amp; the effects on the body</li><li>• What is in a cigarette?</li><li>• Why People Smoke?</li></ul>
Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Discussing alcohol &amp; the effects on the body</li><li>• What are alcoholic drinks?</li><li>• Exploring why people do or don't drink</li></ul>
Year 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Finding out about vaping &amp; E.Cigarettes – effects on the body &amp; laws surrounding them</li><li>• Discussing risk taking</li><li>• Exploring peer pressure and resisting this</li></ul>
Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Drug discussion</li><li>• Exploring drug Goggles and their effects</li></ul>

You may find that your child starts asking questions about the topic at home, or you might want to take the opportunity to talk to your child about these issues. Please let us know if you would like any support in talking to your child about the content that will be covered.
